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CARLE C. ZIMMERMAN and T. UNNITHAN, **Family and Civilisation
in the East and the West**, Bombay: Thacker; and Atlantic High-
lands, New Jersey: Humanities Press, 1975, pp. iv + 173, Rs. 45.

Dr. Carle Zimmerman, a prolific author and one of the greatest family sociologists of all time, has produced one more important volume in the family field.

Professor Zimmerman, who received his Ph. D. from the University of Minnesota, has taught at Minnesota, Harvard University, and other institutions of higher learning in Peru, Mexico, Italy, Germany, Turkey, India, Thailand, and Japan, where he also conducted a great deal of original research. He is associate editor of numerous national and international journals and has published about 20 books, including his famous *Family and Civilization* and *The Family of Tomorrow*, as well as hundreds of scientific articles.

Dr. Unnithan is an internationally known scholar from India, who has taught sociology at various universities in that country. His works include *Gandhi and Free India* and *Sociology of Peace and Non-Violence*.

In the volume under review the authors state that modernization in the Third World cannot be separated from the institution of the family; for the family

influences society and vice versa. Similarly, family change and social change effect each other profoundly. This analysis is based on the comparative approach, which sociologists usually ignore, and which, in this book, involves East and West, and past and present. Dr. Zimmerman's expertise and erudition in this area are both admirable and unsurpassed.

The authors' specific thesis is that the family constitutes the basic social unit and the nuclear family, which is fundamentally the same throughout the world, influence society and vice versa. Therefore, when colonization is followed by independence, certain family changes become necessary. Again, the great master's famous theory of family evolution (primitive-trustee-domestic-atomistic-anarchical) is employed here once more, but more creatively, more fruitfully, and more scientifically than ever.

Some of the book's contents indicate how interesting, how scholarly, and how valuable this work is: history of family sociology, the sociology of Frederic Le Play, a general theory of family systems, the family in East and West, development of the Indian family, history of the Western family, the future of the family, and contemporary family crises and social change.

This important volume contains no sociological jargon. It is both artistically and scientifically written. Furthermore, its bibliography, glossary, and index make it more useful.

We recommend *Family and Civilisation* enthusiastically to scholars, teachers, students, statesmen, and all professionals dealing with the family. Even the intelligent layman will enjoy this masterful volume.
